

### Skills in work 3

For each 'Work detail', decide which **one** of the job titles it best suits. There are **only four** work details per job.

Work details	Doctor	Architect	Tourist guide	Music teacher
Usually very long, irregular hours, over evenings and weekends, and you will be on call				
You can be on your feet all day				
You mainly work in an office, but will also visit sites				
As a junior, you may have to live in the hospital when on call				
You normally work in a school, sixth-form college, community hall, or from home				
Usually a 39-hour week, Monday to Friday, but you may work some evenings and weekends				
Works closely with people such as clients, surveyors and engineers				
The work can be physically and emotionally demanding				
Usually irregular hours, with some evenings and weekends				
The work involves a lot of walking around				
You may have to travel quite a bit, and spend time away from home				
You may be based at one place, such as a stately home, or have to travel widely in the UK or abroad				
You usually work 8:30am to 4pm; Monday to Friday				
You will do some work out of hours, such as rehearsals for concerts and orchestras				
You have to be able to cope with the sight of blood				
You may have to cope with emergencies
